

It's Scholarship Application Time!

CHS Choir Booster Club Scholarship

Application Deadline: April 26th, 2010...4 PM!

The CHS Choir Booster Club will be awarding one \$1000 scholarship to a Coppel High School choir student during the upcoming Choir Banquet. Please review the information below regarding qualifications, the application and selection process prior to submitting your application.

Qualifications:

The applicant must be a graduating senior who is a member of the CHS Choir and has definitive plans to major in music at an accredited college or university. Acceptance at such university/college will be verified. The scholarship will be made payable to the institute of higher learning in the name of the student.

Application:

Applicants will need to complete the attached application form along with a 1– 2 page typed double spaced essay explaining why you feel you should be considered for the scholarship. Since the purpose of the scholarship is to both encourage our students to continue their music education in college and also to recognize their contributions and achievements during their high school choir career, please include the following information in your essay: how long you have been in choir, why choir is important to you, your personal achievements, accomplished goals, and how participation in choir has benefited you. Also describe how your choir experience has impacted your life and how it will influence your future. Include your plans regarding music and your college degree. Do not write your name in or on the essay, only on the attached form.

Application Review and Selection Process

- **Be sure to attach the application form entitled “CHS Choir Booster Scholarship Application” to your essay to help us with identification!**
- Each application will be assigned a number by the non- voting Chairman of the Scholarship Committee.
- The Scholarship Committee will conduct an anonymous review of all submissions. Only after the selection is made, will the committee be informed of the applicant's identity.
